- ⌘ Giving children the freedom and safety to speak with someone about drug abuse within the home.

- ⌘ Activity based support groups for recovering addicts that would be hosted by health mentors. Family would also be encouraged to attend to re-gain their bonds.
- ⌘ Development of a detox, crisis care centre and a local hotline to assist families and addicts in their moment of need.
- ⌘ Set up of a clinical based rehabilitation centre in Bunbury that can provide support for all stages of addiction for both addicts and families.
- ⌘ This will lead on to a farm based release unit where the patients re-learn their real life skills to integrate back into society.
